SYLLABUS

SUBJECT COMPARATIVE LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course will introduce students to variety of models of local government in EU member states. Mile stones of local authorities development will be presented. Legal basis, political and administrative institutions on local level will be explored. Territorial organization, scope of functions, autonomy of finances and institutional setting of local authorities in selected countries will be compared. Issues of local governance will be elaborated.

The course consists of lectures (10 hours) and seminars (10 hours).

- 4) Scandinavian model of local government
- 5) French model of local government
- 6) Local government in federal countries
- 7) From local government to local governance.
