

SUBJECT: Company Law

TEACHER: Dr Roman Uliasz

COURSE DESCRIPTION: the course covers two different forms of companies which are present in modern legislations, namely limited companies and stock corporations. Overall, the course is based on the Polish law, however, various types of companies operating throughout the world will also be presented. Lectures will focus on: company formation, company directors (particular stress will be laid on directors liability), legal personality and its consequences, etc.

LEARNING OUTCOMES: the graduate should be able to make a distinction between limited companies and stock corporations. Also, he should know the benefits of both companies.

GRADING POLICY: the students are assessed on the basis of a short dissertation that must be submitted before the end of semester.

TIMETABLE: students will be informed on the timetable in good time before the classes.

TEXTBOOK AND REQUIRED MATERIAL: chapters from "The Polish Business Law", Rzeszow 2007. The book (or a copy of it) will be distributed among the students free of charge. Additionally, students will be provided with other necessary materials in good time before the classes.

PREREQUISITES: a general knowledge of Civil Law is advisable.
