COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course presents a cycle of cultural and political changes in Central Europe during the late Iron Age. Central European La Tène Culture is presented in wider European and Mediterranean context. The issues of chronological systems, of Celtic culture and its influence on neighboring tribes, as well as of historical written sources are particularly emphasized.
