2.	Manifestations of misuse of leisure (violence and aggression among youth)
3.	Selected problems of the time management (management procedures, rules for the management of time, "thieves working time", how to fight theft free time)
4.	The role of educational environments in the process in the process of educational time
5.	The objective of the project is to prepare the planning time, rational, its organization and the use of basic methods of education in the process of shaping a rational attitudes to free time.
