COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course is focused on the following issues:

- History of therapeutic massage
- Sanitary and safety practices, equipments and products
- Classical massage theory and practice
- Lymph massage theory and practice
- Segmental massage theory and practice
- Optional: massage in medicine theory and practice
- Optional: sports massage theory and practice

LEARNING OUTCOMES

By the end of the course students are expected to:

- Explain theoretical basis of therapeutic massage
- Demonstrate the steps in preparing a room and client for a massage session
- Can give and adjust dosage of: classical massage, lymph massage, segmental massage (optional: massage in medicine, sports massage)
