Authorities and Corporations of Legal Protection

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The course covers the theory of state authorities; constitutional judicial authorities, like:

the National Judicial Council, Supreme Court, organization of courts, administrative courts, the Tribunal of State, the Constitutional Tribunal, the Supreme Control Chamber, the Ombudsman, the Ombudsman for Children, the Inspector General for Personal Data Protection, the National Broadcasting Council.

It also takes up the topic of non-constitutional Authorities of Legal Protection, like: the Public Prosecutor's Office, the Police and international and supranational authorities of legal protection – the European Court for Human Rights, the Council of Europe Commissioner for Human Rights, the European Union Courts, the International Criminal Court, the European Ombudsman, the European Inspector for Personal Data Protection.

It also discusses the corporations of Legal Protection: the notion of corporation; barristers, solicitors, legal advisers; public notaries; court executive officers.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

the student will get knowledge on the authorities and institutions of legal protection in Poland and the European Union, legal basis, appointing and recalling procedures, organization, competence and functioning.
