The competition is open to persons who meet the conditions specified in Article 113 *of the Act of 20 July 2018 on High and Science (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended)*.

**MAIN DUTIES:**

The position combines scientific research with clinical practice. Key responsibilities include:

- ensuring the well-being of laboratory animals and maintaining high standards of ethical handling;
- conducting biotechnological research, participating in preclinical and clinical drug trials, and collaborating with cross-functional research teams;
- maintaining meticulous research records, analyzing data, and preparing comprehensive reports;
- publishing scientific articles in peer-reviewed scientific journals;
- disseminating research results (participation in scientific conferences, science popularisation activities);
- cooperating with the socio-economic environment;
- performing administrative tasks related to the scientific and organisational activities of the university;
  - applying for external research funding.

**QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

- doctor of veterinary medicine (DVM) degree or equivalent;
- valid license to practice as a veterinarian in Poland;
- fluency in English (both written and spoken);
- proficiency in Good Clinical Practice (GCP) and Good Veterinarian Practice (GVP) principles;
- clinical experience with companion and/or livestock animals;

- technical proficiency in: diagnostic imaging (ultrasound operation), assisting and independently performing surgical/medical procedures, general anesthesia (inhalation and intravenous) and patient monitoring, sample collection and processing;
- laboratory skills: ability to perform independent diagnostic tests, including blood analysis (hematology, biochemistry), urinalysis, and basic cytology;
- knowledge of "Fear Free" techniques and stress-reduction handling protocols;
- proven research track record, including scientific publications or conference presentation;
- completed international internship or placement;
- strong teamwork skills and the ability to manage work hours flexibly;
- experience in preclinical research (e.g., rodent models) or knowledge of veterinary regulatory affairs would be a significant advantage;
- additional certifications or postgraduate courses in veterinary sciences are highly desirable.

  - 1) information from the National Criminal Register regarding offences specified in Chapters XIX and XXV of the Criminal Code, in Articles 189a and 207 of the Criminal Code and in the Act of 29 July 2005 on counteracting drug addiction (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 1939, as amended), or for acts prohibited under foreign law corresponding to these offences – **applies to Polish citizens and foreigners**
  - 2) information from the criminal record of the country of citizenship obtained for the purposes of professional or voluntary activities involving contact with children – **applies to foreign nationals;**
  - 3) a statement on the country or countries in which she has resided in the last 20 years, other than the Republic of Poland and the country of citizenship, and at the same time information from the criminal records of those countries obtained for the purposes of professional or voluntary activities involving contact with children – **applies to both Polish citizens and foreigners**
- certificate or information about the level of English language proficiency
- copies of documents confirming qualifications (at least a master's degree or equivalent diploma)
- other documents confirming achievements in scientific work listed in the open call for applications

The competition will be decided within 30 days of the closing date for applications.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

A prerequisite for the employment of a candidate selected in an open recruitment process is that the candidate meets the requirements specified in Articles 113 and 118 of the Act on Higher Education and Science

on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018 (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), as well as the obligation arising from Article 265(5) and (13) of that Act.

When applying for employment at the University of Rzeszów as their primary place of work, candidates employed at other universities as their primary place of work should, on the date of employment, meet the condition specified in Article 120 of the Act of 20 July 2018 The Law on Higher Education and Science (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), according to which an academic teacher may have only one primary place of employment at a time.

Candidates from outside Poland whose diplomas conferring a professional title/academic degree/academic title require official recognition (nostrification) under Polish law may not be employed until the recognition procedures have been completed.

**The competition procedure may be interrupted or cancelled by the Rector without giving a reason until its completion. The decision to employ a candidate is made by the Rector. In justified cases, the Rector has the right not to employ a candidate selected in the competition procedure.**

**The results of the competition do not constitute grounds for Candidates to make any claims against the University of Rzeszów, in particular claims for employment.**

**The competition committee reserves the right to conduct interviews with candidates.**
