COURSE ABSTRACT

The objective of the seminar is to monitor the realization of the research plan, particularly in the form of one-to-one tutorials as well as arranging situations to facilitate exchange of thoughts in the form of critical discussion with other PhD students and experienced artists; discussion on phenomena and trends in contemporary art, analysis of texts on art theory and related fields of study relevant to the concept of a PhD thesis. Collaboration at and consultation about art projects falling into the scope of research interests of the PhD student.

At this stage of learning the objective is to keep students company on their way to development, observe carefully and assist by suggesting options rather than providing specific solutions to artistic problems. That concerns both artistic work and its description.
