### Information clause

1. Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation – GDPR), the University of Rzeszow informs that:
2. The controller of your personal data is the University of Rzeszow, represented by the Rector, with its registered office at al. Rejtana 16C, 35-959 Rzeszow. The controller of personal data has appointed a Data Protection Supervisor who supervises the correctness of personal data processing and who can be contacted by email at: [iod@ur.edu.pl](mailto:iod@ur.edu.pl)
3. **Personal data in the form of an image** will be processed for the following purposes:
  - o documenting, organising and implementing **[name of the event]**,
  - o informing about the course of the event,
  - o promotion and dissemination of the administrator's activities,
  - o publication of information, promotional, archival and reporting materials (including on the controller's websites, in social media and in printed and electronic publications).
5. **The legal basis for data processing** is the consent of the data subject, in accordance with Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR.
6. Providing personal data is **voluntary**, but failure to consent will prevent the recording and dissemination of the image.
7. Personal data will be stored **for the period necessary to achieve the indicated purposes**, but no longer than until the consent is withdrawn, subject to materials published in accordance with the law before its withdrawal.
8. The data subject has the right to:
  - o access to data,
  - o their corrections,
  - o deletion of data,
  - o processing restrictions,
  - o object to processing,
  - o withdraw consent at any time (without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out before its withdrawal).
9. The data subject also has the right to lodge a complaint with the **President of the Personal Data Protection Office** if he or she considers that the processing of his or her personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
