

## METHOD OF CONVERTING GRADES FROM DOCUMENTS ENTITLING HOLDERS TO UNDERTAKE FIRST-CYCLE (BACHELOR'S) OR LONG-CYCLE (INTEGRATED MASTER'S) PROGRAMMES AND SECOND-CYCLE PROGRAMMES

### Conversion of points for first-cycle and long cycle Master's programmes

#### § 1

Percentage results obtained in the secondary school leaving examination ("**new matura**") – the exam taken in the years **2005–2026**, referred to in **Article 70(3)(2)** of the Act on Higher Education and Science, are converted into admission points as follows:

- 1) 1% at the basic level = 1 admission point
- 2) 1% at the advanced level = 2 admission points

#### § 2

Grades obtained in the secondary school leaving examination ("**old matura**") – the exam referred to in Article 70(3)(1) of the Act on Higher Education and Science – are converted into admission points according to the following rule:

#### § 3

Results of an examination or examinations confirming professional qualifications – as referred to in Article 70(3)(3) of the Act on Higher Education and Science and the Act of 7 September 1991 on the education system – or results of vocational examinations referred to in Article 70(3)(4) of the same Act, are taken into account only if specified in the detailed admission criteria for a given programme of study included in Appendix No. 1 to the resolution.

§ 4

1. For candidates who passed the matura examination in a bilingual school, the result obtained at the bilingual level is converted into the equivalent advanced-level result as follows: advanced level = bilingual examination (matura) result and is therefore multiplied by result  $\times 1.3$
2. The result is treated as an advanced-level examination (matura) result and is therefore multiplied by 2.

§ 5

1. For graduates of schools belonging to the **International Baccalaureate Organization**, the results of the **IB examination (International Baccalaureate)** – conducted under the IB Diploma Programme, as referred to in Article 93(1)(2) of the Act of 7 September 1991 on the education system – are converted into admission points according to the following rules:

#### § 7

- In the case of grading systems other than those specified in §§ 1–6, a **percentage conversion** is applied, where the **highest grade in each** grading system corresponds to 100% of the scale and equals 200 admission points with a weight of 0.8.
- If the grading system in a country listed in § 6 or in a country not included in Appendix No. 2 provides for two levels of secondary school leaving examinations (corresponding to advanced and basic levels), the results are converted as follows: basic level – scale 0–100 × 1 admission points, advanced level – scale 0–100 × 2 admission points

#### Conversion of points for second-cycle programmes

#### § 8

- Unless the detailed admission rules for specific study programmes provide otherwise, for second-cycle programmes the grades obtained in the admission interview are converted into admission points according to the following rule:

2. Unless the detailed admission rules for specific study programmes provide otherwise, for second-cycle programmes the arithmetic mean of grades obtained during studies is converted according to the following rule: average grade  $\times$  10 points, rounded to the nearest whole number.

3. Unless the detailed admission rules for specific study programmes provide otherwise, for second-cycle programmes the grade on the graduation diploma is converted into admission points according to the following scale:

4. In case of submitting a document obtained abroad entitling the holder to undertake second-cycle studies, the Admissions Committee (CKR) determines individually in each case the final number of points considered in the admission process, provided that the highest grade in each grading system corresponds to 50 points.4.

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
