Przemysław Żukiewicz is Professor of Political Science and Head of the Department of Civil Society at the Institute of Political Science, University of Wrocław. His research has been funded by the European Union, the Polish National Science Centre, the Ministry of Science and Higher Education, and the International Visegrad Fund. He was a Research Fellow at Dublin City University (2017/18) and has conducted research or lectured in several European countries, Canada, and New Zealand. His research focuses on comparative politics, anti-discrimination law, leadership communication, and democratic backsliding. He is the author of the concept of “supportive leadership”, developed in opposition to toxic and authoritarian models of leadership. His recent work examines populism, political polarisation, and the delegitimation of human rights discourse in contemporary democracies.
