Hanna Bazhenova is a historian, legal scholar, and political scientist. She holds a PhD in World History from Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv (2008) and a PhD in History from John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin (2014). She served as a Research Fellow at the Institute of East-Central Europe (2013–2018) and as a Senior Analyst at the Institute of Central Europe (2018–2026). Since 2021, she has been an Assistant Professor at the Laboratory for International Memory Studies of the Institute of International Relations at Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin. She is the author of eight scholarly monographs, including two co-authored works, as well as numerous publications on Central and Eastern European history and politics. Her main areas of interest include the history of Poland, Russia, and Ukraine; the politics of history and politics of memory; and Ukraine’s domestic and foreign policy and political system.
