Elena Chernyak is Associate Professor of Sociology at Hartwick College. Holding a PhD in Sociology from the University of Windsor (Canada), along with Master's degrees in journalism, social work, and religious studies, she is an internationally engaged scholar whose research focuses on gender, culture, religion, immigration, nationalism, violence, and social inequality, with particular attention to post-socialist and comparative global contexts. Her publications appear in leading peer-reviewed journals and scholarly volumes, contributing to broader debates in sociology, social justice, and human rights. She has presented her work at major international and North American conferences, including the International Sociological Congress, the International Congress of Human Rights, the International Congress on Gender-Based Violence, and meetings of the American and Canadian sociological associations. She currently serves as a 2026 Economic and Social Council Delegate to the United Nations, representing Sociologists for Women in Society.
