Grigorij Mesežnikov is a political scientist, co-founder and incumbent president of the Institute for Public Affairs (IVO), independent Slovak think-tank. He worked at Comenius University and at the Political Science Institute at the Slovak Academy of Sciences in Bratislava. He has published numerous expert studies on party systems' development and political aspects of transformation in post-communist societies, illiberal and authoritarian tendencies, populism, nationalism and hybrid threats in various monographs, collections and scholarly journals in Slovakia and abroad. He has edited and authored dozens of books. In 2006 he was awarded by Reagan-Fascell Fellowship by the National Endowment for Democracy (Washington, D.C.). In 2012 he was a research fellow of Taiwan Fellowship Program at the Department of Political Science of National Taiwan University in Taipei. In 2019–2020 he was a fellow of the Institute for Human Science – Institut für die Wissenschaften vom Menschen (Vienna) at the Europe's Futures program.
