Ireneusz Paweł Karolewski is Professor of Political Theory and Democracy Research at Leipzig University. His research focuses on democratic backsliding, nationalism, identity politics and citizenship in Europe and beyond. He previously held a chair in political science at the University of Wrocław and obtained his PhD and his professorial degree (Habilitation) from the University of Potsdam. Karolewski has been a visiting scholar at institutions including Harvard University, Université de Montréal and New York University. He is the author, co-author or co-editor of numerous books and articles on democracy, nationalism and collective identity including "The Nation and Nationalism in Europe" (Edinburgh University Press) and "Citizenship and Collective Identity in Europe" (Routledge).
