Colonel Jos Bremer (NSPCOE SNR – Royal Netherlands Marechaussee – Chief of Staff).

Colonel Jos Bremer is an officer at the Royal Netherlands Marechaussee.

He started his career at the Royal Marechaussee as Corporal. During this period, he went to the Officers academy and stated a career within the Army at a reconnaissance unit. He assumed several positions at tactical and operational level. During this period, he served a tour in former Yugoslavia (1997). Later he was project manager in the tactical development of reconnaissance equipment. One of his main projects was the reconnaissance vehicle FENNEK.

In 2002 Jos Bremer returned to the Royal Marechaussee and assumed several positions in command and staff positions at operational, tactical, and strategic level. Jos served in Iraq (2003) and Kosovo (2013-2014). From 2017 until 2021 he worked within the NLD MOD directorate operations as senior officer. From 2021 until 2023 he worked as ACOS Ops within EUROGENDFOR.

He is an experienced military and police officer, his subject matter expertise lies in the field of border control, public order management and (stability) policing.

Since 2025 Jos holds the position of Chief of Staff at the NATO Stability Policing Centre of Excellence.
