



## Katarzyna Radzik-Maruszak

Katarzyna Radzik-Maruszak, Associate Professor at Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin, is Director of the Institute of Political Science and Administration and Head of the Department of Public Administration. Her research focuses on comparative public administration, local governance, sustainable local development, civic participation, and the impact of migration at the local level. She has led several research projects funded by the National Science Centre, including studies on local governance, children's and youth engagement in Poland and Finland, and the long-term integration of Ukrainian refugees in Poland and Czechia. She was a visiting scholar at the University of Tampere, Finland and conducted research at Charles University in Prague. Her habilitation monograph received awards from the Minister of Education and Science and the Czesław Mojsiewicz competition. She has presented her work at major international conferences, including ECPR, EGPA, NISPAcee, IPSA and CEPASA.
