Latifa Chakri is a cybersecurity and strategic intelligence expert specializing in Africa and the Middle East. She studied at the former French National Institute of Telecommunications, now part of Institut Polytechnique de Paris. A former cybersecurity reservist commander in France, she has contributed to initiatives related to digital defence, critical infrastructure resilience, and information sovereignty. She founded a cyber intelligence platform monitoring geopolitical and social dynamics in the Arab world. Her work also focuses on combating online child exploitation and pedocriminality in Europe, particularly threats targeting minors through social media, gaming platforms, and encrypted networks. Latifa CHAKRI regularly participates in cyber crisis simulations, risk management programs, and strategic foresight initiatives. In 2025, her warning at GITEX Africa about vulnerabilities affecting energy infrastructures gained attention following the major blackout impacting Spain, Portugal, and southern France.
