Maša Marochini Zrinski graduated in 2007 from the Faculty of Law in Rijeka. She obtained her LL.M. and Ph.D. from the Faculty of Law at the University of Dundee. She has been employed at the Faculty of Law in Rijeka since 2007, in the Department of Theory of Law and State, Philosophy of Law, Human Rights, and Public Policy. Since 2023, she has served as Head of the Institute for Human Rights at the same Faculty.

She has participated as a researcher in numerous scientific and professional projects in Croatia and abroad, and has been a visiting lecturer at foreign universities. Since 2008, she has organised and taught at the Summer School of Human Rights and, since 2009, has served as an academic mentor to law students competing in international moot court competitions.

She has been a member of various committees at the Faculty of Law in Rijeka. She is the author and co-author of several scientific and professional publications, and has been an organiser, lecturer, and participant in numerous national and international conferences and symposia.

Since December 2024, she has served as a judge of the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Croatia, and since April 2026 as its Deputy President.
