Magdalena Pokrzywa is an assistant professor at the Institute of Sociological Sciences of the University of Rzeszów (Poland). He has a PhD in sociology and professional qualifications to work as a social worker. Her research interests focus on social inequalities, gender issues and the sociology of work. She is also involved in research on social exclusion, poverty, media portrayals of marginalized groups, the situation of migrants in the labor market, organizational behavior, and workplace dynamics. She is the author and co-author of numerous scientific publications. Her most recent work includes analyses of workplace discipline, employee engagement, unethical pro-organisational behaviour and their consequences for the culture and quality of organisations, as well as research on poverty, multidimensional social exclusion, disability and the situation of women in the context of poverty and other social problems. Previously, she served as the representative of the Rector of the University of Rzeszów for equal treatment.
