Piotr Burgoński, PhD, is a senior lecturer and deputy director of the Institute of Political Science and Administration at Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński University in Warsaw. His research focuses on EU equality and anti-discrimination policy, the ideological dimension of political processes, and the intersection of religion and politics. He is the author of the award-winning monograph **Patriotism in the European Union** (National Centre for Culture Award). Dr Burgoński is a member of the editorial boards of the journals **Christianity**, **World, Politics** and **Athenaeum**. Polish Political Studies. He is also a member of the board of the Polish Community of European Studies (PTSE) and the Polish Political Science Association (PTNP). As an expert in EU political theory and the role of ideas in public life, he combines theoretical research with an analysis of practical anti-discrimination mechanisms.
