Beata Przybylska-Maszner – Assistant Professor and Head of the Department of European Integration Studies at the Faculty of Political Science and Journalism at the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań. She is a member of the European Commission's network of experts Team Europe Poland, Vice-President of the Centre for European Documentation in Poznań and Chair of the Scientific Council of the Polish Association for European Studies. She is also the editor-in-chief of the Yearbook of European Integration. She has coordinated and participated in numerous international research projects, including VALUES – a network on EU foreign policy disputes and RENPET Reconceptualizing European Power in an Era of Turmutter: Contestation, Relevance and Sustainability. Her research focuses on the institutional development of the European Union's Common Foreign and Security Policy and its impact on the EU's political relations with partner countries and regions. He specializes in EU institutional reform and coordination of the Union's external action. Her work contributes to scientific and policy debates on the EU as a global actor, particularly in the context of multilateralism, institutional transformation and the evolving architecture of European governance.
