Ryan G. Ceresola is a sociologist, criminologist, and educator serving as Chair of the Department of Sociology, Criminology, and Human Services at Hartwick College. His research focuses on political corruption, conspiracy theories, white-collar crime, social trust, and environmental sociology. He has published in journals including *Crime, Law and Social Change*, *Voluntas*, *Rural Sociology*, *Teaching Sociology*, among others.

Ceresola's recent scholarship examines how education, political ideology, and trust shape belief in conspiracy theories in the United States, presenting this work both nationally and internationally. In addition to his research, he teaches courses in criminology, conspiracy theories, white-collar crime, quantitative methods, and the sociology of popular music.

Beyond scholarship, Ceresola has been active in institutional leadership, faculty governance, community engagement, and student mentorship.
