Professor. Doctor of Historical Sciences. Professor of the Department of History, Faculty of Humanities of the Ukrainian Catholic University (UCU).

In 1994-2014, he studied and taught at Donetsk University. In 1984-1991, he studied at the Faculty of History, graduating with honors. In 1991-1994, he studied at the postgraduate level in the Department of History of Ukraine. Since 2012, he has been teaching at UCU. In 2021–2022, he was professor at the University of Rzeszów, Institute of Political Science.

Scientific interests:

- Modern Russian-Ukrainian war: military, political and economic strategies.
- Ukrainian refugees and displaced persons during the Russian aggression.

He has over 250 scientific publications.

Since 2022, as a volunteer consultant, he has been cooperating with units of the Armed Forces of Ukraine and also coordinating the activities of the international expert group “The Cossack Factor in the Russian-Ukrainian War”.
